COMPETITION RULES



COMPETITION RULES

1. GENERAL

Competitions are open to all club members except sections E and F but members are limited to one entry in each section at each meeting.

2. JUDGING

Judges will award positions, first, second and third as they consider correct.

3. SECTIONS

- A. Cut foliage or flowers or berries. Quality to count (not quantity), minimum 3, maximum 9 blooms or stems.
- B. Pot or pan grown plant for foliage, flower or fruit (including berries).
- C. Fruit.
- D. Vegetables.
- E. Ladies Only. Cut foliage or flowers or berries. Quality to count (not quantity), minimum 3, maximum 9 blooms or stems.
- F. Ladies Only. Pot or pan grown plant for foliage, flowers or fruit (including berries).
- G. Floral Arrangement.

H. Cacti and Succulents.

J. Roses 3 stems or blooms of one type.

K. One single cut specimen of any type.

4. GUIDELINES FOR COMPETITIONS

- i. Competitors must complete the entry form provided.
- ii. All entries must have been grown by the Exhibitor. This does not apply to Section G.

5. PRIZES

At the Annual General Meeting trophies and cash prizes won for each section will be presented for the previous calendar year's results as follows:

Villiers Challenge Cup

Awarded to member with the highest number of points in Section A.

Eric Snow Memorial Cup

Awarded to member with the highest number of points in Section B.

Poupart Challenge Cup

Awarded to member with the highest number of points in Sections C and D.

Burnham Challenge Cup

Awarded to the lady member with the highest number or points in Section E.

Gladys Stanley Trophy

Awarded to the lady member with the highest number of points in Section F.

Arthur Workman Challenge Cup

Awarded to member with the highest number of points in Section G.

Caller Trophy

Awarded to member with highest number of points in Section H.

Pinckney Challenge Cup

Awarded to member with highest number of points in Section J.

Percy Wiseman Challenge Cup

Awarded to member with highest number of points in Sections A, B, C, D, G, H and J.

Charles Kaynes Memorial Trophy

Awarded to member with highest number of points in Section K.

Joan Ford Trophy

Awarded to member with highest number of points who has otherwise not won a cup.

William & Maisie Sarney Trophy

Awarded to member with highest number of points overall.
